Hello, this is Anita.

Today we are doing a grammar lesson.

The subject is Future with going to.

Statement

I am/ 'm going to clean the shoes.

You are/ 're going to clean the shoes.

He/ she/ it is/ 's going to clean the shoes.

We are/ 're going to clean the shoes.

You are/ 're going to clean the shoes.

They are/ 're going to clean the shoes.

Negative

I am/ 'm not going to clean the shoes.

You are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.

He/ she/ it is/ 's not going to clean the shoes.

We are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.

You are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.

They are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.

Question

Am I going to clean the shoes?

Are you going to clean the shoes?

Is he/ she/ it going to clean the shoes?

Are we going to clean the shoes?

Are you going to clean the shoes?

Are they going to clean the shoes?

We use be going to + infinitive if:

- we talk about something which has been already decided or arranged

Where are you going to travel on holiday this year?

I'm going to buy a new house.

My parents aren't going to move to a new house this month.

- we make a prediction based on a present situation that makes clear what is going to happen

Look at that man! He is going to fall off.

You look terrible. You are going to be sick.

It's beautiful weather now. It isn't going to rain today.

Note!

We can use the Present continuous if we say what we have arranged before (e.g. a meeting).

I'm meeting Mrs. Jones in the afternoon.

I'm not having any more lessons today.

### A jövőidő a going to-val

Szia, Anita vagyok.

Ma nyelvtanozni fogunk.

A lecke tárgya a jövő idő a going to-val.

Állítás

I am/ 'm going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogom tisztítani a cipőt.

You are/ 're going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogod tisztítani a cipőt.

He/ she/ it is/ 's going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogja tisztítani a cipőt.

We are/ 're going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogjuk tisztítani a cipőt.

You are/ 're going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogjátok tisztítani a cipőt.

They are/ 're going to clean the shoes.\*Ki fogják tisztítani a cipőt.

Negatív

I am/ 'm not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogom kitesztítani a cipőt.

You are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogod kitesztítani a cipőt.

He/ she/ it is/ 's not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogja kitesztítani a cipőt.

We are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogjuk kitesztítani a cipőt.

You are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogjátok kitesztítani a cipőt.

They are/ 're not going to clean the shoes.\*Nem fogják kitesztítani a cipőt.

Kérdés

Am I going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogom tisztítani a cipőt?

Are you going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogod tisztítani a cipőt?

Is he/ she/ it going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogja tisztítani a cipőt?

Are we going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogjuk tisztítani a cipőt?

Are you going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogjátok tisztítani a cipőt?

Are they going to clean the shoes?\*Ki fogják tisztítani a cipőt?

A be going to + szótári alakot használjuk, ha:

- valamiről beszélünk, ami már el lett döntve vagy rendezve

Where are you going to travel on holiday this year? ' Hová fogtok utazni nyaralni ebben az évben?

I'm going to buy a new house. ' Venni fogok egy új házat.

My parents aren't going to move to a new house this month. ' A szüleim nem fognak ebben a hónapban költözni.

- előrejelzést teszünk egy jelenlegi szituáció alapján, ami egyértelművé teszi, hogy mi fog történni

Look at that man! He is going to fall off. ' Nézd azt az embert! El fog esni.

You look terrible. You are going to be sick. ' Rettenetesen nézel ki. Beteg leszel.

It's beautiful weather now. It isn't going to rain today. ' Csodás idő van. Ma nem fog esni.

Jegyezd meg!

A Folyamatos Jelen időt is használhatjuk, ha elmondjuk, amit már korábban elrendeztünk (pl. egy találkozót).

I'm meeting Mrs. Jones in the afternoon. ' Találkozom Mrs. Jones-al délután.

I'm not having any more lessons today. ' Ma már nincs több órám.
